Background

The town is a centre of engineering excellence offering good jobs, schools and medical services. Recreation opportunities include motocross, heated indoor pools, Lake Moana-nui, Waikato River Trails and a planned multi-million dollar Events Centre. Residents enjoy a proud sporting heritage, rural lifestyles and celebrate cultural diversity.

Tokoroa's long term development is currently at a crossroad. Now is the opportunity to turn around the town's fortunes by working toward a shared vision of prosperity and well-being. Your ideas can help create a real difference for the future of Tokoroa.

How to get involved

Council has kicked off a planning process for Tokoroa and surrounding areas. The process is being guided by a steering group of Council officials and community members.

The aim is to identify a shared vision for Tokoroa, and principles for its future development. The Tokoroa Concept Plan will be considered by Council and other groups as part of their own future planning.

Timeframes include initial community consultation scheduled for April '08 and in July and August we will conduct a public feedback period for the draft plan.
