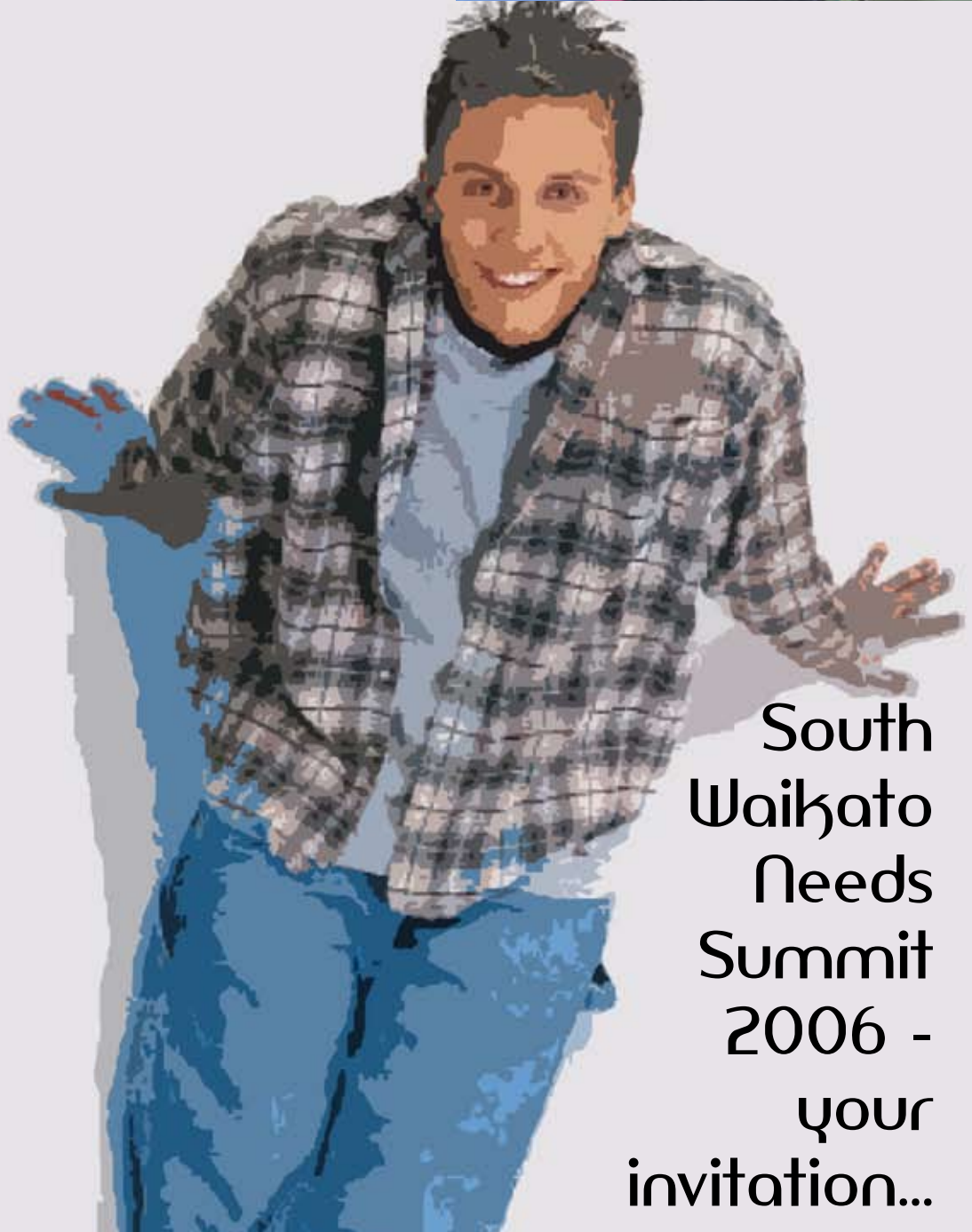

Working better together

South Waikato's Sustainability Indicator

For the first time, information about the full spectrum of community wellbeing in the South Waikato has been brought together in one place. The Draft State of the District Report shows the South Waikato is progressing well in terms of business growth, business and community confidence, community pride and cohesion, access to recreation and education facilities and quality of the natural environment. However the report also highlights a number of key areas in which we could be better as a District.

South Waikato's Sustainability Indicators will stay in draft form until late 2007 to allow sufficient time for community feedback, and to enable staff to compile further data including the results of the 2006 Census. The report will become an

increasingly valuable tool for assessing how well the District's groups and organisations are working together to promote community wellbeing.

The 2006 Need Summit will also include an update and discussion on the South Waikato Youth Strategy. A Steering Group was formed in late 2006 to drive the development of the Strategy, comprising representatives of Council, Raukawa Trust Board, South Waikato Safer Community Council and the Ministry of Youth Development. Work is currently under way to ensure youth voices are represented on the Steering Group. Over the coming months the Group will plan and oversee a process to develop the Youth Strategy and ensure broad buy-in from young people as well as schools and other stakeholders.
